

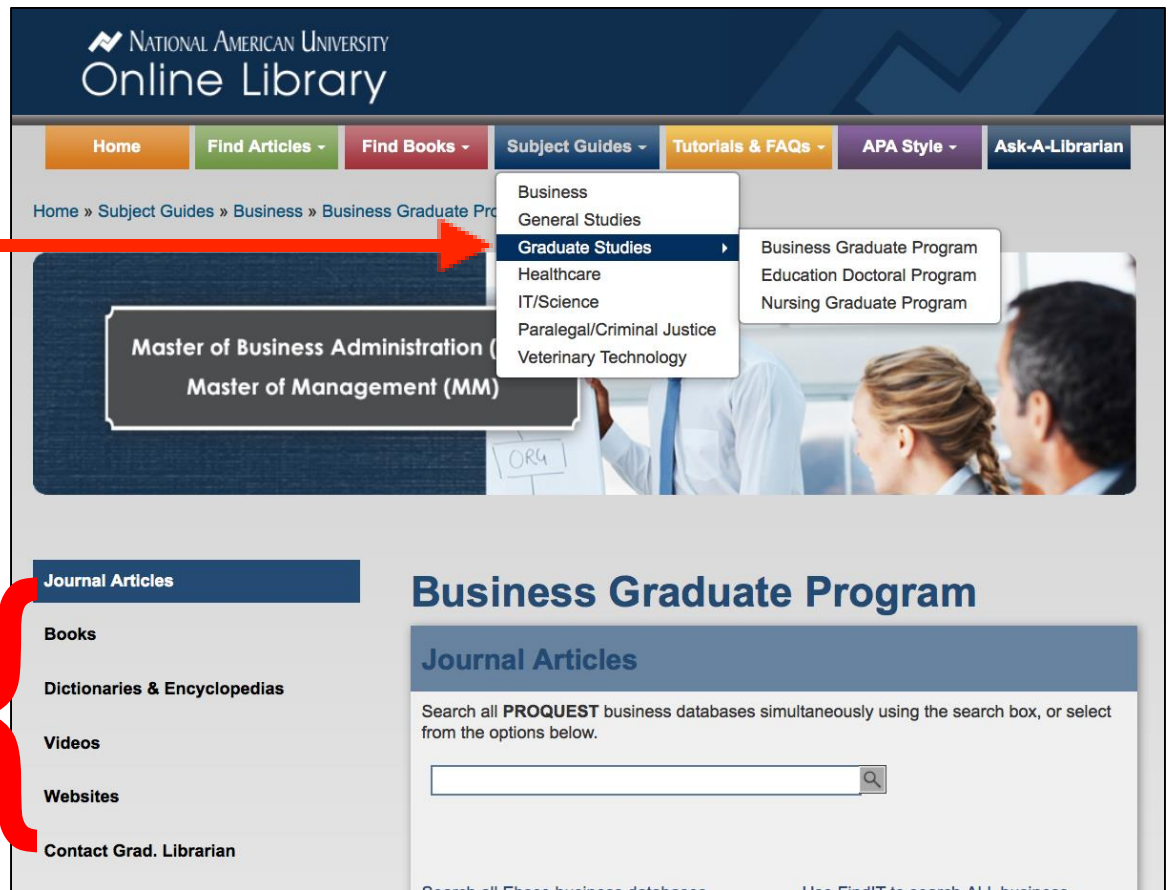


Library Resources for Graduate Faculty and Students
