

How to Write a Prompt for an AI LLM

Select the Al's Specific Software Settings.

The different large language model (LLM) artificial intelligence (AI) text generators have different settings that can be user-set before starting your prompt. Ensure the settings are where you would like before you begin the assignment. (e.g., "creative").

Elements of a Good AI LLM Prompt

- 1. **Contextual Role:** Let the generative Al tool know its role (e.g., "You write clear explanations of concepts," "You are a curious teenager," "You are the subject matter expert"), as this can provide vital context that helps ensure the Al is answering your prompts in the correct tone and manner.
- 2. **Concept:** Tell the Al within your prompt the idea you are focused on. If you're using a tool connected to the internet (e.g., Bing Creative Mode or Google's Bard), tell it to research the concept using seminal references and core works in the field.
- 3. Audience: Tell the AI the audience you will speak to in the finished text.
- 4. **Available specifics and delimitations you have set:** Tell the AI precisely what you need (e.g., "a clear three-paragraph explanation," "two specific examples," "an analogy relevant to today's workplace").
- 5. **Style:** Describe the style of writing you prefer (e.g., "straightforward," "concrete," "dynamic," "engaging," "humorous.").

Things to Remember (SPREADS)

- 1. **Keep it Simple**: Use clear and concise language to describe what you want the AI to create.
- 2. **Use Positive Language**: Using positive language can help the Al understand the desired outcome and may lead to more successful results.
- 3. **Use References**: Including references can help the AI understand the style and subject matter you want it to include.
- 4. **Use Examples**: Providing similar examples of what you want the AI to create can help it understand your vision.

- 5. **Use Adjectives**: Adjectives can help the Al understand the mood or style you want to create.
- 6. **Include** Details: The more details you include in your prompt, the more accurately the AI can generate what you have in mind.
- 7. **Be Specific**: The more specific you are in your prompt, the more likely the Al will be able to generate what you want.

Things to Do to Avoid Mistakes:

- 8. **Eliminate Ambiguous Language**: Ambiguous language can lead to confusion and may result in the Al generating an image that doesn't match your vision.
- 9. **Remove Conflicting Terms**: Using inconsistent terms in your prompt can lead to confusion and may result in the Al generating something that doesn't match your vision.
- 10. **Resist the** First Answer: Experiment with different prompts and revise as needed to get your desired results.

Here's an example prompt that puts this all together:

"You are a faculty member who generates clear, accurate explanations of concepts for students. Provide a clear multiple-paragraph explanation of espionage using two specific examples and give me three analogies I can use to help students understand the concept in different ways."
